When I was younger there was a song we use to sing and I am sure many still know it. It was about Jesus being lifted high and the line "prayer is a powerful weapon, stronghold come tumbling down" was sung with gusto in my church. As a child this made an impression on my heart. Prayer=Weapon.

I think for some prayer can be seen as an old school practice, meant for some but not for all. We pray to say thank you for our food and God's protection. And when a dark day comes we pray for God's intervention. But I have come to believe that prayer should be a way of life. Prayer is a tool of offence and defence for God's people.

In the book The Prayer Saturated Church this statement is quoted "The definition of success is: finding out what is on Jesus' heart and then doing it, when and how He says to." There is a revelation with this statement as it highlights one of the key purposes of prayer. "Prayer is not a program. It's a

movement beginning in the heart of God."
